

11. The David Lockton Challenge

"A competition that **excludes** any member who has;-

1. Earned anything from their photography in the last 5 years. (Sales at the Wakefield C C Exhibition Excepted)
2. Has been awarded any photographic distinction (letters after their name – like LRPS, or CPAGB)
3. Won any photographic competition or been placed 2nd or 3rd (Our On-line Competition Excepted)
4. Has won the David Lockton Challenge (Those placed 2nd, 3rd, or lower in the David Lockton Challenge may re-enter the following year)

Qualifying Members may submit up to three (3) digital images in this competition. There is no restriction as to subject or manipulation of the image(s) except that all the images used are from photographs taken by the author.

The member with the winning image will hold the David Lockton Challenge Trophy for one year and also receive a Glass Trophy (or other suitable memento). 1st, 2nd and 3rd places and any Highly Commended, or commended entries will receive a certificate.

Only **paid up qualifying** members are eligible for entry to the competition.

Digital images must be in JPEG format. Images may be of any size, but not wider than 1600 pixels, not higher than 1200 pixels. **(if you have a problem with this, please ask any member of the committee for help).**

Entries should each have a title and be in a folder that shows your membership number and the name of the competition (The David Lockton Challenge).(see separate instruction if you are intending to email your entry).

As an example, my folder for the Dave Lockton Challenge, would read ;

Submissions must be given to the Competition Secretary [or other specified recipient] on or before the date specified in the syllabus and/or on our web site. The Folders should be on a memory stick.

Emailed Entries; If you choose to email the images, please put your membership number, the competition (The David Lockton Challenge) in the subject bar. Then attach your images.

All Images submitted to competitions must have been photographed by the entrant. Any manipulation of images must be the work of the author.

An image can only be entered into this competition once, but the same image may be entered into one Clubman competition, one Annual, one Maurice Biglin Wildflower competition, one Triptych competition and one Monthly on-line competition.

Members shall at all times have control over the use of their property. Copies of images may be used on the Club website, in publicising the club and in YPU or Inter-Club competitions.

Members must inform the competition secretary if they do not want their images used in this way.

Judges appointed are empowered to decide eligibility of entries and mark down as they feel fit.

A Judge will be appointed to judge the David Lockton Challenge. The Judge will be invited to comment on each image, select 1st, 2nd and



3rd places and award Commended or Highly Commended classification to as many images as he/she wishes.

Competition rules and any amendments will be published on the club's web site.

David Lockton was born on the 23rd of August 1927 and died on the 25th of June 2017.

He joined Wakefield Camera Club in 1956 and at the AGM on the 7th February 2005 was made a Life member for his services to the club.
